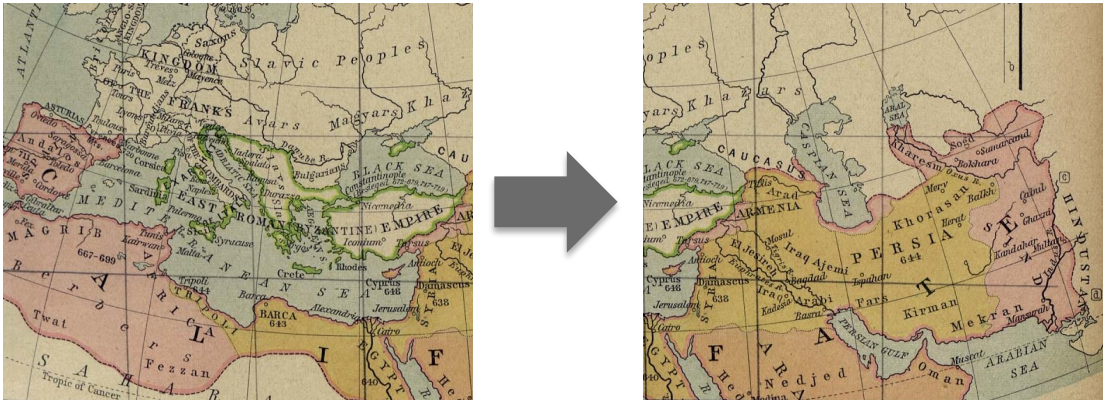


# What Would It Take to Move the Map?
